Please submit entries as CMYK documents saved in either Photoshop or Illustrator format with all fonts either outlined or included with the submission. If you intend to submit a design, please send an email to loci@theprintmanufactory.com with the following details as soon as possible: Name, Email address, URL (if applicable), Hometown, and your chosen **locus**. As we hope to cover a broad spectrum of locations, it is imperative that we get a preliminary list from contributors to ensure a minimum of duplication.
